Join us for a fun evening for a chance to socialise and have some food and drink and maybe get stuck in and take part in the open mic.



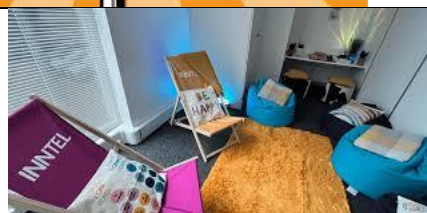
The event will be at the International Anthony Burgess Foundation Centre (IABF) in Manchester city centre.
